Advocacy committee: Has met for first time. Summary of what was covered:

- Purpose is to identify ways for Board and staff to advocate for Center and the arts, primarily through building relationships with organizations and individuals in the community. Part of taking on local leadership role in arts, cultural programming.
- Start with ensuring all Board members and staff are consistent with way they view Center and comfortable with talking about its essence.
- First step with County: go as group to County Commissioner meeting. During public comment time, thank them for support and talk about what we have achieved.
- Next: invite individual commissioners to Center.
- Board members should wear their name tags; thank volunteers and staff regularly; work on personal relationships w donors.
- Establish relationships with other arts/nonprofit groups by first contacting individuals for more information.

Advisory council:

- Will be a"brain trust" of local individuals and organizations that can offer advice on programs, resources, new directions, etc. People and/or organizations interested in arts, culture, building community, giving back to community, helping create opportunities for individual/community growth. Meet as a group 2-3 x/year to talk over 1-2 topics.
- Size: recommended 12-15. Carefully selected group.
- Approach: a representative of the Center talks to the individual: what can we do to serve
 your community/your customers? Individual may be part of an organization where the
 role is delegated to others. Follow up with a letter. Notify via letter when a council
 meeting is scheduled, what it is about.

Action item for everyone next month: Bring potential names.

Old/New business: Orientation, plan for identifying new Board members.
